Theory:

- 1 Exam Pad
- 1 Wide lever arch file

Practical:

Provision for Colour Photocopying and printing

Needed throughout the year:

- A container to store all your art supplies
- Portfolio holder A2 (can be homemade)
- Visual Diary: A3 size
- Pencils: 2H / HB / 2B / 6B
- Powder pastels or oil pastels
- Ruler
- Pencil sharpener
- Eraser (Nice to have: putty rubber)
- Glue
- Scissors

Term 1: Soap Sculpture

- Soap Bar
- Carving Tools
- Container to hold the soap sculpture
- Newspaper / paper plate to work on
- Black pen or marker

Term 2: Squashed faces: self portrait

- Brushes: (this is quite a personal but it is nice to have a wide range of small and big brushes)
Big, flat, Camel hair brush size: # 1, 3, 6, 12
small brushes for detail # 000, 1, 3
- Nice to have: Masking fluid (blocking out certain areas)
- Acrylic paint: (I would suggest Zelcryn Artists' acrylic paint)
Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium red / Vermilion Red Hue
Ultramarine Blue
Cerulean Blue
Deep Cadmium Yellow
Titanium White
Black
Yellow Ocher
- Pallet / polystyrene plate: (this is used for mixing paint on)
Nice to have: Tear-off palette sheets and palette knife
- Cloth and water container: for cleaning paint brushes
- Permanent marker and fine liner (various colours)
- Good quality A3 size paper (200g and up)
- A2 Black Mounting board or Super board or Presentation board

Term 4: Expressionistic Shoes

- Black Parker ink
- Jik
- Soft pastels or oil pastels
- White acrylic paint
- Drawing inks in various colours
- Black fine liner
- Good quality A2 size, drawing paper
