## FIRST DAY OF TERM - 17 January 2024

- Learners to be at school by 07:30.
- New learners assemble on the driveway near the main entrance.
- Full summer uniform (all garments marked with learner's name).

Blazers are not necessary if it is hot. Please note jerseys may only be worn under the blazers, unless they are short sleeve pullovers, in which case blazers are not necessary.

- School ends at 14:25 on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday and 14:15 on Tuesday and Friday.
- Learners to be collected at their respective gates.

## PROGRAMME FOR FIRST WEEK FOR GRADE 8 LEARNERS

All Grade 8 learners will be involved in a full orientation and integration programme on 15 and 16 January (two days before school starts) (07:30-14:30 on both days). There is no initiation. During this time learners get to know one another and their teachers and this ensures that they settle into high school without any problems.

The Grade 8s finish at the end of the normal school day every day for the rest of the first week.
In early February all Grade 8 s will be inducted into the school and there will be a meeting for Grade 8 parents/guardians. This is an event at which we require everyone's attendance.

## TEXTBOOKS AND STATIONERY

The school supplies textbooks but in some subjects, workbooks are used. Parents/guardians may have to pay for these. Parents/guardians are required to provide the stationery indicated on the stationery list (can be ordered from the Parent's Association).

Blue tunic or Khaki pants (from the uniform shop)
*White glad neck shirt (not a button-up shirt with stiff collar)
Navy V-neck jersey (to fit correctly) (blazer must be worn)
Navy sleeveless V-neck pullover (to fit correctly) (blazer does not need to be worn)
*White ankle socks
*Plain black leather school shoes
Black swimming costume (not team costume)
Blue swimming cap
Team swimming costume (only for team members)
Muslim learners may, if they wish, wear a head scarf and trousers (both items are compulsory) in the colour of the school tunic (the scarf may also be navy) (not available at the School Shop at present) or the regulation school khaki pants with the head scarf.

Sports' Uniform (Physical Education)
School shorts/ plain black/navy shorts
House t-shirt (in the colour of the allocated House)
Individual sports kit as per the requirements of the sport.

The School Shop stocks all of the above items except those indicated with an asterisk (*). The School Shop runs on debit/credit and ALLXS card basis (not Diners Club). Debit/Credit cards are accepted in the School Shop and at the Finance Office.
